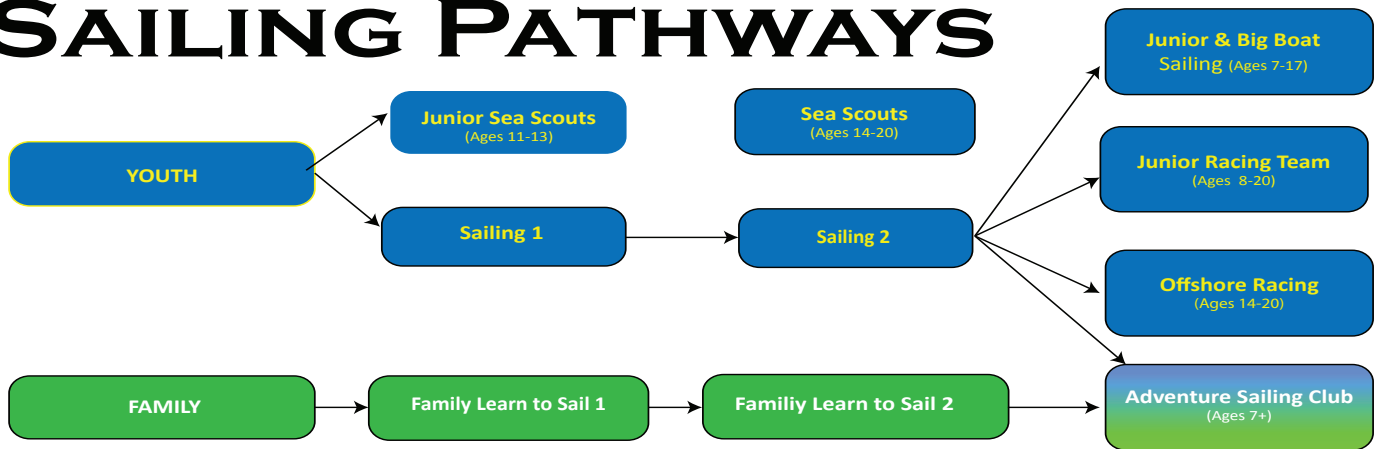


SAILING PATHWAYS



Sailing 1 (Three consecutive SUNDAYS) or *Family Learn to Sail 1 (SATURDAYS)

In this BEGINNING sailing class, students learn to rig the boat, steer, tack, and jibe. They can expect to also improve their self-confidence, teamwork, judgment, and responsibility.

Sailing 2 (Three consecutive SUNDAYS) or *Family Learn to Sail 2 (SATURDAYS)

In this INTERMEDIATE class, sailors will refine their boat handling skills in increased wind conditions while working on communication and sportsmanship.

Successful completion of either Level 2 Sailing class qualifies youth and/or families to join the Adventure Sailing Club for continued recreational sailing on Sunday afternoons. Alternatively, youth of appropriate ages interested in learning to race sailboats may try out for the Junior Racing Team or the Offshore Racing Team.

Junior Sea Scouts (Ages 11-13)

For youth interested in continuing a passion for being on the water yet not old enough to join a Sea Scout program, the Newport Sea Base offers two semesters annually of its Jr. Sea Scout program. Students learn the fundamentals of boating safety, small boat handling, types of vessels, experiences in sailing, motor, and paddle craft, and take on leadership roles during their final semester in the program. Interactions with members of the local Sea Scout ships lead to friendships that may last a lifetime! No sailing prerequisite.

Sea Scouts (Ages 14-20)

In this youth-led and adult-mentored 104-year old program, elected youth leaders plan and conduct the program under the guidance of adult leaders. Scouts develop important leadership and life skills as they learn to maintain and safely operate their vessel, navigate buoys and lights, drop anchor and dock approach. No sailing prerequisite.

Junior Big Boat (Ages 7-10) & Big Boat Sailing (Ages 11-17)

These summer-only programs introduce sailors to the exciting world of keelboats.

*Family Learn to Sail classes enables parents and children to learn to sail together. The instruction parallels that of the youth sailing classes.
