Course Description:

Here are a few items we ask you keep in mind while preparing for class:

- Be sure your Scout picks up a syllabus from the instructor on the first day of class and reviews the syllabus with parents/guardians.
- Class handouts and this letter can be found on the [Merit Badge Resources](#) page of our website.
- Scouts should bring the merit badge booklet to each day of class. (Note: Some requirements changed in 2019)
- Most of the merit badge requirements and course information are covered and discussed in class, however we do assign 2 homework assignments.
- Scouts **MUST WEAR CLOSED TOED SHOES AT ALL TIME**. No sandals, Crocs, or roller shoes are permitted.
- Scouts should label all personal belongings.
- Electronics and other valued items should be left at HOME. Sea Base is not responsible for any lost, stolen or broken items.
- 12 p.m. to 1 p.m. is supervised lunchtime. Scouts are not permitted to leave the Sea Base without a parent/guardian.
- On the final day of class, bring a blue card signed by your Scoutmaster.

This highly interactive and exploratory class is open to and enjoyable for all youth (girls & boys, ages 11-17), not just Scouts.

Note: Orange County Council, Boy Scouts is dedicated to the safety of all youth who participate in our programs. Consequently, Scouts must be able to repeat back, in their own words, an accurate understanding of all safety instructions. Scouts who are unable or unwilling to do so, may not be eligible to participate. (Youth who are working on their English language skills can decide to bring an interpreter but may still not be eligible to participate.)
